

COUNTY TREASURER APPOINTMENT COMMITTEE

In accordance with Michigan Election Law, the Bay County Treasurer Appointment Committee comprised of Probate Judge Jane Miner, Prosecuting Attorney Nancy Borushko and County Clerk Kathleen Zanotti, announces it is currently accepting applications for their consideration. By statute, the Committee is authorized to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of County Treasurer Shawna Walraven, effective May 3, 2022.

This appointment would be to fill the unexpired term of office through December 31, 2024. Applicants would be responsible for filing the necessary paperwork to file as candidate in accordance with Michigan Election Law for the August primary and November General Elections in 2024, the opportunity to be elected to a full, four-year term of office following the expiration of the appointment period ending December 2024.

The two main roles of the Treasurer are as the custodian of all county funds and the collector of delinquent taxes. The County Treasurer serves on several boards, including the County Election Commission, Chairperson of the Bay County Land Bank Authority, Bay County Retirement Board, Bay County Voluntary Employees' Beneficiary Association Board and Plat Board. The annual salary is \$79,938.

Applicants must be 18 years of age, a resident of Bay County, Michigan, and be a registered voter of Bay County, Michigan. Background checks will be conducted under provisions of the Bay County Personnel Policy.

Applicants are instructed to complete an online application and include a letter of interest and resume through the Bay County employment opportunities website. Interviews will be conducted June 13, 2022. Once selected, the candidate must be available to assume the role of County Treasurer on or about June 15, 2022.

The next meeting of the Treasurer Appointment Committee will be Monday, May 23, 2022, beginning at noon in the 4th floor Commission Chambers of the Bay County Building 515 Center Avenue, Bay City, Michigan.
