

PUBLIC NOTICE

BAY METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY PROPOSED STATE AND FEDERAL 49 USC SECTION 5311/SECTION 5307 APPLICATION FOR OPERATING AND CAPITAL ASSISTANCE

All citizens are advised that the Bay Metropolitan Transportation Authority (BMTA) has prepared an application for State of Michigan financial assistance for fiscal year 2023, as required under Act 51 of the Public Acts of 1951, as amended, and for Federal 49 USC Section 5311 assistance as required under the Federal Transit Act, as amended.

BMTA is requesting \$3,085,366 in state operating assistance for general public transit services; \$2,711,038 for Federal 49 USC Sections 5311, 5307, and 5303 operating assistance. For Federal 49 USC Section 5339, BMTA is requesting \$153,759 for maintenance equipment, 2 lift vans, and concrete replacement.

The proposed application is on file at the Bay Metropolitan Transportation Authority, 1510 N. Johnson Street, Bay City, MI 48708, and may be reviewed during a 30-day period (February 1, 2022 through March 2, 2022), between the hours of 8:00 am to Noon and 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm Monday through Friday.

Written comments regarding the application and/or written requests for a public hearing to review the application must be received by March 2, 2022. If a hearing is requested, notice of the scheduled date, time and location will be provided at least 10 days in advance. If no hearing is requested, this will serve as final notice.

BMTA ensures that the level and quality of transportation service is provided without regard to race, color, or national origin in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
