Synopsis of Regular Meeting

September 18, 2023

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Kathleen L. Newsham at 6:00 PM.

The following items were approved:

- City Commission Minutes (9/5/23)
- Accounts and Claims in the amount of \$699,204.88 and Investments and Wire Transfers in the amount of \$248,958.79 (9/11/23), and Accounts and Claims in the amount of \$521,902.32 and Investments and Wire Transfers in the amount of \$565,409.24 (9/18/23)
 - Payroll in the amount of \$1,239,321.33 (9/18/23)
 - Request of Kevin Novellino, on behalf of the Brooklyn Boyz, to hold Bay City's Welcome Table on September 23, 2023, using the 500 block of Midland Street
 - Memorandum of Understanding and Data Sharing Agreement between the Bay City Department of Public Safety and Families Against Narcotics, Inc.
 - Budget amendments in the amount of \$359,040 for the Fiscal Year 2023/2024 budget
 - Traffic Control Order #2023.009 to prohibit parking on the north side of 1st Street, N. Madison Avenue and N Lincoln Street
 - Traffic Control Order #2023.010 to change the traffic flow at 2nd Street, Grant Street, and Sherman Street to one-way in the area specified in the TCO
 - Traffic Control Order #2023.011 to remove the traffic signal at the intersection of Madison Avenue and 3rd Street and replace it with a 2-way Stop Condition
 - Traffic Control Order #2023.012 to remove the traffic signal at the intersection of Woodside Avenue and Grant Street and replace it with a 2-way Stop Condition
 - Resolution recommending Contract No. 22-5275 with the Michigan Department of Transportation, designating the City as the Public Authority with jurisdiction over Independence Bridge
 - Resolution supporting the Reconnecting Communities and Neighborhoods Grant submission
